# **RESOLUTION 7-13**

## **RESOLUTION OF NECESSITY TO CONDEMN REAL PROPERTY**

**WHEREAS**, Part III, Chapter 3, Title 7, of the California *Code of Civil Procedure* (§§1230.010-1273.050) authorizes acquisition of property rights for public utility purposes by eminent domain procedures; and,

**WHEREAS**, the real property described here is required for the improvement of the sewer system of the Lake Shastina Community Services District; and,

WHEREAS, this Board of Directors of the Lake Shastina Community Services District finds and determines that notice of its intention to adopt this Resolution of Necessity was duly given as required by law, and on the date and at the time and place fixed for hearing, this Board did hear and consider all of the evidence presented:

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by at least a two-thirds vote of this Board of Directors under California *Code of Civil Procedure* §§1240.030 and 1245.230, that this Board of Directors finds and determines each of the following:

- 1. The public interest and necessity require the proposed project.
- 2. The proposed project is planned or located in the manner that will be most compatible with the greatest public good and the least private injury.
- 3. The property sought to be acquired is necessary for the project.
- 4. The offer required by *Government Code* §7267.2 has been made to the property owner or owners of record.

**AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that Robert D. Winston of Kirsher, Winston & Boston, LC, General Counsel to the Lake Shastina Community Services District, is authorized and directed to commence and maintain a proceeding in the Superior Court, County of Siskiyou, to acquire for the Lake Shastina Community Services District a fee simple interest in that certain real property designated and described as Exhibit A, attached hereto, and including an application for an Order for Possession Before Judgment of said real property; and,

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Treasurer, Chief Financial Officer, or General Manager of the Lake Shastina Community Services District is hereby authorized and directed to draw its warrant on the said District in the amount of One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), the warrant to be made payable to the Clerk of the Superior Court, County of Siskiyou, and delivered to the District's aforesaid General Counsel, to be deposited with the payee as security for the aforesaid Order for Possession Before Judgment; and,

#### SEWER FACILITY PARCEL



BEGINNING AT A POINT ON THE NORTHEASTERLY LINE OF VALLEY VIEW DRIVE ACCORDING TO TRACT No. 1000-9-1, FILED IN THE OFFICE OF THE SISKIYOU COUNTY RECORDER ON APRIL 27, 1972 IN BOOK 5 OF TOWN MAPS, PAGE 107-110 INCLUSIVE, SAID POINT BEARS SOUTH 4°25'25" EAST, A DISTANCE OF 826.88 FEET FROM THE NORTHWEST CORNER OF SECTION 25; THENCE NORTH 89°41'17" EAST, A DISTANCE OF 78.92 FEET; THENCE SOUTH 39°09'38" EAST, A DISTANCE OF 50.00 FEET; THENCE SOUTH 50°50'22" WEST, A DISTANCE OF 55.00 FEET, MORE OR LESS TO A POINT ON THE NORTHEASTERLY LINE OF VALLEY VIEW DRIVE, SAID POINT LYING ON A CURVE CONCAVE TO THE SOUTHWEST HAVING A RADIUS OF 384.94 FEET AND A RADIAL BEARING OF NORTH 54°33'48" EAST; THENCE NORTHWESTERLY ALONG SAID CURVE, THROUGH A CENTRAL ANGLE OF 14°53'04" FOR AN ARC DISTANCE OF 100.00 FEET TO THE POINT OF BEGINNING.

#### **PUBLIC HEARING:**

3. Public Hearing: Consideration to adopt Resolution of Necessity - Eminent Domain: James and Deborah Lea, APN 020-270-320:

Pres. Moller read proposed Resolution of Necessity to Condemn Real Property by Eminent Domain in its entirety. (District Counsel Robert Winston stated that Exhibits A and B were distributed with the proposed Resolution). Public Hearing opened at 5:07 p.m. A Rancho Hills Community Association representative asked what property was named in the resolution. No other comments or questions were received. Pres. Moller closed the Public Hearing at 5:07 p.m. GM McCarthy reviewed the purpose of the proposed Resolution: The District's Sewer Pump Station 116 is location on APN 020-270-320; it is the main pump station at Rancho Hills. The property is being taken for the station and access to the station (.093 acres).

Motion by Dir. Cupp second by Dir. Mitchell to accept information received and adopt Resolution 7-13: Resolution of Necessity to Condemn Real Property by Eminent Domain (James and Deborah Lea, APN 020-270-320).

- 5. Update on repairs to Wastewater Lift Pump Stations B-103 and B-105: PWS Moser gave a PowerPoint presentation showing emergency repairs to Lift Pump Stations B-103 and B-105.
- 6. Discussion / consideration of Fire and Police fees for the June 3, 2014 primary election: District Counsel Robert Winston answered Board questions regarding a Public Safety fee initiative: 1) Fire and Police fees could be combined on one vote and 2) the initiative can include options to deal with inflation. The Board discussed. Pres. Moller stated that she was calling a Special Meeting on September 28, 2013, 9:00 a.m. at the Administration Building as an opportunity for the Board to receive constituent input and for an opportunity for citizens to discuss options for a successful ballot initiative.
- Update on cost of appraisal study for Lake Shastina Medical Clinic: GM McCarthy reported that the cost of a commercial appraisal for the LS Medical Clinic is estimated at \$3,000 to \$4,000. Pres. Moller directed GM McCarthy to confer with attorney if the CSD should proceed with an appraisal.
- 8. Dwinnell Dam: threat to remove, by Klamath Riverkeeper Group / Karuk Tribe: No report.
