Gayle Wetter nominated Errol Murphy to fill the position. No other names were presented to the Board. Dir. Moller stated that she was unaware that notices had been posted and that the Board would be ready to fill the position at this meeting.

Motion by Dir. Roths second by Dir. Cupp to appoint Errol Murphy to fill Board Member vacancy – term through December 7, 2012.

- 8. Wastewater Ponds: update: GM McCarthy reported that bid documents are being worked on for the new sewer ponds. The District is waiting for the Water Board's response regarding the liner design for the new ponds.
- LSPOA request for sign placement on CSD property: The Board reviewed the sign design provided by the LSPOA.
 Pres. Wetter stated that the LSPOA agreed they would be responsible for the sign, including maintenance.

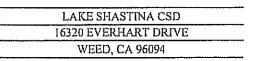
